## Psalms 22-23 Three Psalms about Messiah

- The Shepherd and the sheep
- The Servant Suffering

# **The Sovereign Crowned**

In Psalm 23 we saw the Messiah living in voluntary obedience to the Father and under his protection.

In Psalm 22 we saw the Messiah in his final act of obedience and his vindication.

In Psalm 24 we see the final stage of the journey – his ascension and glorification.

### The destination at the journey's end

- The hill of the LORD
- The holy place of the LORD

David would have been thinking about the Temple he was preparing to be built, knowing that it was only a shadow of the real holy place, cf Psalm 2:6, 132:1-7, 2Chron. 6:18-21.

### The core question is in verse 3 – "Who ...who?"

David was aware that this was a serious problem, Psalm 51.

Isaiah discovered the peril of standing in that place, Isaiah 6:1-5.

What should result in blessing and vindication (acceptance) v5 could end in disaster.

### The problem has its origin in a contradiction:

- 1) Who lives in the holy place? "The LORD" v1-3
- 2) Who proposes to make the journey? "Jacob" v4b, 6b, cf Psalm 15.

## 1) Who is The LORD? v1-2.

The context is a worldview characterised by relativism and superstition,.

There is only one God; He is the LORD – the God who revealed himself to Moses, the God of Israel, Deut. 6:4

- Everything was created by him and belongs to him cf. 1Corinthians 10:26 the food is already blessed.
- Nothing can threaten us, Gen. 1:1-2, 9-10, Psalm 104:26 (Waters, sea monsters, sun etc are creatures, cf Psalm 121).
- Everyone is answerable to him and must obey his summons of Psalm 100.
- We must come to where he is, and on his terms of Deut. 12:1-14, 16:1-2, 13-16.

# 2) Who is qualified to make the journey and stand in the holy place?

- **His character** v4-6 (as revealed in Psalms 22 and 23).

He is **worthy** Rev. 5. Truth, rather than power, is the issue cf John 18:37-38, 19:10-11.

- His identity v7-10.

He is the LORD of Hosts – the same LORD as in v 1-2. This is the mystery 1Tim. 3:16, Colossians 1:15-17.

### Many things flow from his ascension and coronation

- The outpouring of the Holy Spirit Acts 2: 33-36, 3:19-21.
- **Heaven and earth are joined** John 1:51, Heb. 9:24, 10:19-22
- We are seated with him in the heavenlies (in authority over alien spiritual powers) Eph. 1:19-23, cf 2:4-7 & 6:11-12
- Anointed leadership to raise up the people of God Eph. 1:19-23, 4:7-13
- History and the destiny of the nations are in the hands of Jesus Rev. 5:1-5, 1Cor. 15:24-28, Psalm 2, Daniel 7:9-14, John 5: 27, Acts 17:30-31. He will return as King Acts 1:9-11, Rev. 1: 7, 19:11-16
- His people will share in his glory John 17: 22, Heb. 2:10, and be in his presence John 17: 24, 14:2-3, 1John 3:2.
